




Bottom View Top View







Notes

- 1. Material can be either Brass, Copper or Aluminium
- 2. The thickness of the walls is not important, in the diagrams they are shows as 5mm.
- 3. The flattened area should be approximately 15mm by 15mm, to accommodate the SMA sockets.
- 4. The four outer holes for mounting the SMA sockets should be drilled and tapped M2.5.
- 5. The centre hole for the SMA sockets should be large enough for the extended Teflon centre of the sockets. This is M4 and a little hand filing is needed.
- 6. The hole opposite to the 3cms feed should be drilled and tapped M3 for the adjustment screw.
